The Big Knitted Christmas Tree

Can you help - Knit Together - Build Community!

Your squares will join those knitted by others to create a Giant Community Christmas Tree on display at Christ Church, Epsom during December 2017, after which they will be turned into blankets for charity.

What to knit or crochet?

Basic instructions for a square:

- Use Double Knit (DK) green yarn (any shade) on 6mm needles.
- Cast on 40 stitches.
- Garter stitch only (all rows) until work measures 8 or 10 inches. Cast off.
- Any shade of green.

Instructions for more experienced crafters:

- Knit (or crochet) Christmas tree decorations – all shapes & sizes.
- Not too small, and no bigger than 10 inches tall.

Ideas for younger people:

- Knit smaller squares and make different coloured pom-poms as baubles.

Where to knit?

- Anywhere! *Why not set up your own knitting group?*
- Or with others such as Christ Church Contemplative Art Group or at the Stitch Mouse regular workshops

Drop squares off at The Stitch Mouse, South St. Mon – Sat 9am-5:15pm, or to the box in Christ Church porch any Sunday.
