# JOB SPECIFICATION

- To broaden and deepen the musical aspects of the church's worship through planning a
  diverse repertoire for worship. (We are in the process of reviewing our current patterns of
  worship it is hoped a new DOM would have input into this)
- To play the organ at all morning services, at festivals and at occasional services, and to direct the choir as they sing.
- To rehearse the choir on a weekly basis (currently Thursday evenings).
- To prepare music and rehearse the band twice monthly for band led services.
- To be accountable to the Vicar for all matters relating to music in the parish.
- To liaise regularly with the Vicar to plan musical ministry and outreach, and to attend quarterly Worship Planning Meetings.
- To work closely with clergy, LLM's and choir in selecting and preparing music for worship.
- To co-operate with the Parish Office staff over printing and administrative matters.
- To work with couples in the preparation and choosing of the music for their marriage, including those who have asked for the choir to sing at their marriage.
- To play the organ at marriage services as countenanced by the agreed contract, and to facilitate the use of the organ by other organists when not available.
- To play the organ for church funeral services as countenanced by the agreed contract, and to facilitate the use of the organ by other organists when not available.
- To continue professional development.
- To sign and work in accordance with a contract based on the relevant standard RSCM contract.
- To complete an enhanced DBS check.
- To liaise with Shepherds to ensure the organ is regularly tuned and maintained.
